Definition of IFRA 3	Eye products of all types (eye shadow, mascara, eyeliner, eye make-up, eye masks, eye pillows, etc.) including eye care and moisturizer. Facial make up and foundation. Make-up remover for face and eyes. Nose pore strips. Wipes or refreshing tissues for face, neck, hands, body. Body and face paint (for children and adults). Facial masks for face and around the eyes.
Definition of IFRA 4	Hydro alcoholic and non-hydro alcoholic fine fragrance of all types (Eau de Toilette, Parfum, Cologne, solid perfume, fragrancing cream, aftershaves of all types, etc.). Fragranced bracelets. Ingredients of perfume kits and fragrance mixtures for cosmetic kits. Scent pads, foil packs. Scent strips for hydro alcoholic products.
Definition of IFRA 5A	Body creams, oils, lotions of all types. Foot care products (creams and powders). Insect repellent (intended to be applied to the skin). All powders and talc (excluding baby powders and talc).
